

## Pushpay Arbitration Opt-Out Form For Individuals Only

To opt-out of binding arbitration for disputes governed by our <u>User Agreement</u>, you must complete and email this form to <u>ArbitrationOptOut@pushpay.com</u> no later than 30 days after the date of acceptance of the User Agreement. You must complete this form by providing all the information it calls for. You must sign the opt-out notice for it to be effective. This procedure is the only way you can opt-out of the agreement to arbitrate. If you opt-out of this Agreement to Arbitrate, all other parts of the <u>User Agreement</u> will continue to apply. Opting-out of this Agreement to Arbitrate has no effect on any previous, other, or future arbitration agreements that you may have with us.

This Opt-Out Form is for Individual users only. If you are an Organization or Developer, you are ineligible to opt-out of binding arbitration.

You understand that if you opt-out of binding arbitration any and all disputes or claims that have arisen or may arise between you and Pushpay including federal and state statutory claims, common law claims, and those based in contract, tort, fraud, misrepresentation or any other legal theory, shall be resolved exclusively by the courts located in King County, Washington, and you and Pushpay agree to exclusive jurisdiction and venue of the courts located in King County, Washington, and you and Pushpay forever waive any right to assert forum non-conveniens. You further understand that the <u>User Agreement</u> remains in full force and effect except as expressly modified pursuant to this Arbitration Opt-Out Form.
